**Sub: Withdrawal of Provisional Affiliation of Anupama College of Engineering, Bhora Kalan, Pataudi, Road, Near Bilaspur Chowk, Distt. Gurgaon for running existing B.Tech degree course.**

Sir,

It is stated that the AICTE vide letter No. 765-62-214(E)/ET/95 dated 22.9.2011 has withdrawn the recognition of your College for running existing B.Tech course in view of the glaring deficiencies/shortcomings mentioned in the letter under reference. In the light of the withdrawal of recognition by the Central Body i.e. AICTE, the matter was placed before the Academic Council of this University in its meeting held on 14.10.2011 to consider the matter with regard to withdrawal of provisional affiliation of Anupama College of Engineering, Bhora Kalan, Gurgaon and to decide the fate of existing students of the College studying in various disciplines of B.Tech. Degree course.

The Academic Council in its aforesaid meeting considered the matter recommending to the Executive Council that the provisional affiliation of the College for running B.Tech degree course be withdrawn in phases in the light of the provision under Clause 12(d) of Statute-38 of M.D. University Act and the AICTE be informed accordingly.

Meanwhile, the AICTE vide its letter dated 13.10.2011 addressed to the Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Technical Education Department, Govt. of Haryana, Secretariat, Chandigarh with a copy to this University requested for ensuring the

transfer of existing students of Anupama College of Engineering to some other affiliated institutes under intimation to the Council.

In the light of the above recommendations of the Academic Council and in view of the letter of the AICTE dated 13.10.2011, the matter was placed before the Executive Council of this University for deciding the issue of withdrawal of provisional affiliation of Anupama College of Engineering, Bhora Kalan, Gurgaon and fate of the existing students. The Executive Council of this University considered the matter in its meeting held on 30.11.2011 and resolved vide Reso. No. 26 as under:-

#### **RESOLUTION**

**[The Vice –Chancellor informed the House that a letter bearing No. 765-62-214(E)ET/95 dated 13.10.2011 has been received from the AICTE after the meeting of the Academic Council held on 14.10.2011 requesting for transfer of the existing students of Anupama College of Engineering to some other Colleges under the jurisdiction of the University under intimation to the AICTE so that necessary approval for creation of supernumerary seats, if needed, to accommodate such students in other College(s) may be granted.**

In view of the above, it was :]

**RESOLVED that the recommendations of the Academic Council as above be approved.**

**RESOLVED FURTHER that a committee be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for shifting the existing students of the College in the nearby colleges by seeking their options and keeping in view the availability of seats etc., and that the final position be intimated to the AICTE.**

**RESOLVED also that the Academic Council be apprised of the above action in its next meeting.**

In view of withdrawal of recognition by the Central Body i.e. AICTE of your Institute and pursuant to the decision taken by the Executive Council of this University thereon, the provisional affiliation of your institute i.e. Anupama College of Engineering, Bhora Kalan, Gurgaon for existing B.Tech degree course is hereby withdrawn by this University. Further, in the light of the directions of the AICTE vide its letter dated 13.10.2011 and in terms of above decision of the Executive Council the shifting of students of your institute in the various existing disciplines of B.Tech course shall be made in other affiliated institutes of this University in the very near future, for which the matter is under active consideration. Hence no fees etc. should be charged from the

students. A copy of this disaffiliation order must be displaced on the notice board of the College for information of all concerned including students.

A copy of letter of AICTE dated 22.9.2011 withdrawing the recognition of the College and a copy of letter of AICTE dated 13.10.2011 giving directions for ensuring the transfer of the existing students from Anupama College of Engineering to other affiliated institutes alongwith a copy of resolution of Executive Council of the University dated 30.11.2011 are enclosed for reference.
