Subject:- Awareness campaign regarding promotion of Technical Education in the State.

Haryana Government has expanded the network of technical education institutions i.e. Polytechnics and Engineering colleges in the state. Today, there are 175 Polytechnics in Government/Private sector in Haryana. The entrance qualification is class X and successful completion of DET (Diploma Entrance Test). Currently, less than twenty five percent of children from Government schools participate in this exam. Therefore, the number of children entering into Polytechnics comes from this small group. It is essential that we make all children aware of the availability of these technical institutions and their admissions process.

Technical Education Department has been requested to make children aware of these opportunities by holding counselling sessions in the schools. The staff from Polytechnic would be contacting the school Principals/Headmasters for these awareness generation sessions. They may be provided full cooperation in the matter.
